



Pay out in Singles, Doubles and Team is at least 1 in 10 entries. All prizes will be determined by the amount of entries received. Prize fees paid into the Four Events will be returned as prizes of these events.

TOURNAMENT AVERAGE WILL BE USED between (6) games to forty five (45) games. If no tournament average, then the bowler will use their USBC Standard composite average for the year of 2021-2022. If no USBC Average then the bowler will use 229 scratch, (If they want to get into pots and brackets), on Saturday. Otherwise bowl (6) games on Saturday, with (no pots or brackets), to establish an average for the weekend and the tournament. Handicap will be based on 80% OF your tournament average subtracted from 230.
