Attached you will find the information on the upcoming membership school & compliance training. Out of courtesy to those hosting, please get accurate attendance numbers in by the deadline. You will also see information on bids for the next 2024 Membership School and 2025 Bowling Tournament. As of today we haven't received any bids for these. Please complete the bid sheet and return to State Madam Secretary Pat Murney as soon as possible. Thank you!

Below is a list of items that should already be completed:

- 1. Put all 2023-2024 officers in the MMS. Make sure that all their contact information is correct and up to date. Once this is done, please email a pdf copy of your current officers (MMS Reports, Club Management, Current Officers List) to State Madam Secretary Pat Murney: mistauxsec@gmail.com.
- 2. All Per Capita Taxes; Grand Aerie, Funeral Benefit and State are now **PAST DUE**. We have (6) Auxiliaries that have not paid the Grand Aerie PCT. We have (7) Auxiliaries that have not paid the State PCT. You can find the invoices under Reports>PCT. Make sure you write a separate check for each invoice due (Grand, Funeral, State).
- 3. IRS 990 E-postcards are also due (Google 990 Postcard). If your Auxiliary had less than \$50,000.00 you should do an e-postcard. Once you have all your books audited you will be able to complete this. It only takes a few minutes. Print a copy of this and mail it to the Grand Aerie along with your Annual Treasurer's Report. The Treasurer's Report and Auditor's Report can be found on your MMS. (Reports>GA Accounting>PCT)
 - There are several Auxiliaries that are more than a year behind in doing their 990. We have (86) Auxiliaries that need to get this past year's 990 done. These need to be done as soon as possible. Failure to do so will result in your Auxiliary losing it's non-profit status.
- 4. A lot of the Insurance Company's do not forward a complete copy of the Policy to the Grand Aerie. Please get a **full copy** of the policy from your Aerie and send it in to the Grand Aerie. It can be emailed in also as there are usually a lot of pages of this document and the Grand needs to receive **every page**. We have (27) Auxiliaries that need to get a copy of the Policy to the Grand Aerie. Auxiliaries must also be bonded. We have (28) Auxiliaries that are not bonded. (This information can be often be found in your Aerie's insurance policy.) If you are bonded on your own policy, then all pages of this policy needs to be sent to the Grand Aerie also.
- 5. By-laws need to be up to date and approved by the Grand Aerie, not more than (2) years old.
- 6. Affiliation Agreements also need to be up to date. We currently have (14) Auxiliaries delinquent.

You can see where your Auxiliary is at for Compliance on the home screen of your MMS or what you are missing on the next few pages. State Auxiliary Officers are here to help anyone that have questions or that need help. Please give the state office a call (989-965-1697) or email (mistauxsec@gmail.com), so we can help you. Please note per our rules & regulations, the completion of the above are required to receive your compensation.




