However, in case of emergency, a substitute bowler may bowl more than once per by-law no. 20.
5. To bowl in singles or doubles you **MUST** bowl both.
6. **Entries will close at 11:00 A.M. April 27, 2025**
7. Entry fees must accompany all entries. The tournament manager reserves the right to reject any entry.
8. Team captains Check in time is one (1) hour prior to the time of bowling.

Averages will be calculated using 90% of the difference between a bowlers average and 220 If no USBC average then the bowler will use 219 scratch, (if they want to get in pots or brackets), on Saturday. Otherwise, bowl (6) games on Saturday, with (no pots or brackets), to establish an average for the weekend and the tournament. Handicap will be based on 90% of your tournament average subtracted from 220.
