RULES FOR THE 2024 MENS STATE EAGLES BOWLING TOURNAMENT

Hosted at B's Bowling Center Hosted by Burton Aerie 3814.

The tournament shall be a handicap tournament consisting of three events. Five man team, Doubles and Singles events. USBC sanction is NOT necessary

Entry must be filled out completely (PLEASE PRINT) as all information is necessary for notices, reports and final prize payout.

All entries must be received fourteen (14) days before bowling. Entries are open until 10:00 AM on April 27, 2024.

Mail application(s) and monies to Eagles State Bowling, 7050 M-33 Cheboygan, Michigan 49721.

Bowlers will bowl in the order they are listed on the entry form. Any substitutes will bowl where the team captain wants them and agreed on by the Director before bowling.

Bowlers wishing to enter All Events will pay \$3.00 entry fee when application is submitted to be eligible for prizes in this event. Prize payout is at least 1 in 20 entries. Pay out in Singles, Doubles and Team is at least 1 in 10 entries. All prizes will be determined by the amount of entries received. Prize fees paid into the Four Events will be returned as prizes of these events.

ALL PRIZE MONEY IS RETURNED 100%.

Competition restricted solely to F.O.E. AERIE MEMBERS ONLY (Male or Female).

All USBC members are eligible to receive high score (300 games, 800 and 900 series) recognition. NON USBC members may receive the award at a cost of \$25.00 paid to the Director.

Bowlers must report for check-in before bowling to prove they are FOE updated members in their HOME AERIE.

First place Jackets for each Event, All-Events, 300 games, 800 and 900 series will be awarded to individual bowlers. Payout will be within 45 days after May 1, 2024

All protests of errors in scoring must be made in writing to Tournament Director not later than 36 hours after bowling.

Bowlers may participate more than once but cash only once in Singles and Doubles with the SAME partner. May cash more than once in Doubles with Different partner. Teams must have at least two (2) different bowlers.

TOURNAMENT AVERAGE WILL BE USED between (6) games to forty five (45) games. If no tournament average, then the bowler will use their USBC Standard composite average for the year of 2021-2022. If no USBC Average then the bowler will use 229 scratch, (If they want to get into pots and brackets), on Saturday. Otherwise bowl (6) games on Saturday, with (no pots or brackets), to establish an average for the weekend and the tournament. Handicap will be based on 80% OF your tournament average subtracted from 230.
